APPROVED END-USER TARIFFS FOR THE SECOND QUARTER OF 2024

The Authority at its 391st meeting, considered and approved Uganda Electricity Distribution Company Limited (UEDCL) to charge end-user tariffs that are in harmony with the National Grid tariffs for all the nine (9) service territories including Central-North, Mid-West, South-Western, North-Western, Southern, Rwenzori, North-Eastern, North-North-Western and Eastern Service Territories for the period July 2023 to June 2024.

The Authority at its 403rd meeting considered and approved the following;

- i. End-User tariffs to be charged by UEDCL for the period April to June 2024 as shown in Table 1.

- ii. The Bulk Supply Tariff (BST) to be applied by Uganda Electricity Transmission Company Limited on energy purchases by UEDCL shall be; Ush 323.5/kWh, Ush 248.9/kWh, and Ush 161.7/kWh at Peak, Shoulder, and Off-peak respectively for the period April to June 2024

- iii. A lifeline tariff of Ush 250/kWh applicable to the first eight (8) electricity units billed to a domestic customer every month across all the service territories; and,
- iv. The monthly fixed charge and other charges remain unchanged.

The Uganda Electricity Distribution Company Limited is required to publish the approved tariffs in a newspaper of wide circulation in the respective concession areas and share a copy of the publication with the undersigned within ten (10) days of receipt of this letter.
